



Announcing **FREE GRAPES** for the picking!

Six Days - September 8th-13th, 2014

Our vineyard at Country Moon Winery in Noblesville is observing a Sabbath year with our Concord grapevines. These vines were left unpruned this past Spring but have produced a crop estimated at 4000 pounds.

In Leviticus 25:5 it reads, "your grapes of untrimmed vines you shall not gather..." This word for "gather" (Strong's #1219 in Hebrew) more accurately means to "enclose or fortify." So on the Sabbath year, we are "opening the gates" to the vineyard and inviting the community to partake in the Concord harvest.

Picking grapes is a fun outdoor activity great for youth groups, team building, food pantries, fundraising...even for the making of communion juice or wine.

When:

- Picking dates are Monday, September 8th through Saturday, September 13th.
- Each day opens at 8:00 a.m. and closes at 7 p.m.
- Groups can come and go as they like.
- No reservation is necessary.

What to bring:

- clippers
- buckets (3-5 gallon #2 plastic)
- sturdy shoes, long pants, hats, sunscreen
- sack lunches, water, soft drinks and coolers
- lawn chairs
